**Memory Verse: 2 Corinthians 5:17**

<sup>17</sup> This means that anyone who belongs to Christ has become a new person. The old life is gone; a new life has begun!

**Read:** John 8:1-11

**Discuss:**

- Was the woman in this story accused fairly? How do we know?
- What was the penalty for her sin?
- What do you think they were trying to “trap” Jesus into saying when they brought her to Jesus?
- What do you think Jesus was writing on the ground?
- How do imagine the woman felt when the crowd started to disperse?
- How do imagine the woman must have felt when Jesus forgave her?
- Do you think Jesus’ request to “Go and sin no more” was too much to ask?
- What does it mean to Repent?
  - Repentance
  - Greek Word: Μετάνοια – Metanoia
    - A change of heart – resulting in a change of direction.
    - Discuss what that looks like both physically and spiritually in terms of sin.
- Do you think the woman obeyed Jesus’ request? Why?

- How about you? Have you surrendered your life to Christ?

  - Confess & Repent from your sins.
