Memory Verse: Colossians 3:5 "Put to death, therefore, whatever belongs to your earthly nature: sexual immorality, impurity, lust, evil desires and greed, which is idolatry."

This morning Pastor Steve said "Sexual sin grows like a deadly weed in the garden of our lives. The Bible is clear about it's dangers and gives us a clear path to defeat this monster." One example of how this sin grew into a deadly weed is the relationship between King David and Bathsheba.

  - Do you use content controls for your TV, Phones and Internet?
- What are other ways Sexual Sin tries to creep into our lives?
  - o How can we prevent/or safeguard ourselves and our families from these sins?
