Memory Verse: John 11:25 (NLT) "Jesus told her, "I am the resurrection and the life. Anyone who believes in me will live, even after dying."

This morning, Pastor Steve's message focused on Matthew 8, reminding us that Jesus has the authority to heal. Jesus does not have to use His hands to perform a miracle--His words alone are powerful enough to heal.

Read John 11 to Go Deeper into the story of Lazarus and how he was healed by the words of Jesus. Discuss the chapter and questions below with your Grow Group or family.

John 11:1-16

- Could Jesus have healed Lazarus from where He was days before Lazarus died?
- Why didn't He heal him from where He was?
- Why did Jesus wait and not leave right away?

John 11:17-44

• What happened because Jesus waited to heal Lazaraus in HIS timing?

Jesus did not have to be physically present in order to heal Lazaraus but the faith of his family required Jesus to be present. This morning Pastor Steve said "Lord I KNOW you can, I PRAY you will, but I TRUST you if you don't."

- How does your faith relate to this story, in regards to the healing power of Jesus?
- How do you feel about this statement "Lord I KNOW you can, I PRAY you will, but I TRUST you if you don't" ?
- How do you think each person in this story would have reacted if Jesus DID NOT heal Lazarus?

There are many ways we can be broken and need to be healed: Physical, Emotional, Mental, Relational, Spiritual.

- How has Jesus healed you in the past?
- How has Jesus healed someone you know?
- Who do you know that needs healing now?
- Have you ever had to "wait" for healing?
 - What did you learn during(from) your time while waiting for you or someone else to be healed?
