This morning Pastor Chris took us through Luke 24 and “The Walk to Emmaus”. Pastor Chris said “The greatest thing you can do for someone else is: Teach them God’s Word”.

- What was your first thought when Pastor Chris said that statement? (Yes, absolutely! Maybe, or no)
- If you agreed, do you think your life currently reflects that?
- What are some ways you currently teach others God’s Word?

Pastor Chris reminds us that forever is coming and now is the time to make sure we are teaching everyone we can about God and what He has done for us. Just as in today’s passage where He prepared the hearts of the followers, God is preparing the heart of who He is sending you. **Luke 24:32** “They said to each other, “Didn’t our hearts burn within us as he talked with us on the road and explained the Scriptures to us?”

- How are you preparing your heart and mind to teach those who God sends you?
- What else are you doing to prepare for opportunities to share your faith?

Sharing and teaching others about God does not always mean we will be the one who will get to see the “seeds planted” grow. Sometimes God sends us someone who we start planting seeds in, other times we get to water the seeds already planted by someone else, all of this leads to someone getting to help the people grow in Christ.

Read **Luke 24:13-49** about the The Walk to Emmaus and answer the questions below.

- What is one thing that stood out to you from this week’s message?
- What do we learn about the power of the Holy Spirit in this week’s passage?
- How have you experienced the power of God in your life? How does this experience change you and equip you?
- Who has God prepared and sent you in the past?
- Is there anyone who you think God sent you in your life currently that you need to or are ministering to?
- How can we pray for you?
