This week Pastor Chris White took us through Acts 10, telling us about Peter, Cornelius, and Peter's vision. Last week, Pastor Steve Williams took us through Acts 9 and at the very end of the chapter there is something quickly mentioned that could seem insignificant—but was actually a big deal.

**"43** And he stayed in Joppa for many days with one Simon, a tanner." **Acts 9:43** This verse from Acts 9 tells us that Peter stayed in Joppa with Simon, a tanner. Because Simon was a tanner of hides—meaning there were dead animals that he was working with—this would be considered unclean.

There is a correlation between Peter's vision in Acts 10 and Peter staying with Simon. The point for Peter is to open his eyes to the Gentiles in salvation and stop treating them differently or not associating with them because of old Jewish laws in regards to things being unclean.
