1. **1 Corinthians 13:4-8** “4 Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud. 5 It does not dishonor others, it is not self-seeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs. 6 Love does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth. 7 It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres. 8 Love never fails. But where there are prophecies, they will cease; where there are tongues, they will be stilled; where there is knowledge, it will pass away.” **15 Pointes**

20. **Ephesians 6:16** “16 In all circumstances take up the shield of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming darts of the evil one;” **5 Pointes**
21. **Ephesians 6:17-18** 17 and take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God, 18 praying at all times in the Spirit, with all prayer and supplication. To that end, keep alert with all perseverance, making supplication for all the saints, **10 Pointes**
22. **Galatians 2:20 NIV** “I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. The life I now live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me.” **5 Pointes**
23. **Galatians 5:22-23** 22 But the Holy Spirit produces this kind of fruit in our lives: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, 23 gentleness, and self-control. There is no law against these things!” **10 Pointes**
24. **Genesis 1:1** 1 In the beginning, God created the heavens and the earth. **5 Pointes**
25. **Hebrews 13:6** “So we say with confidence, “The Lord is my helper; I will not be afraid. What can man do to me?” ” **5 Pointes**

Scripture Memory Incentive Program–NPKids Pointes

All verses are worth pointes. When a child can say the verse correctly the first time they receive the amount of pointes on the list. Every week they may say the verse again to earn one pointe per Sunday (repetition should be encouraged to help kids retain the verse). The Gospel Project verse will count as **10 pointes** the first time.

On the last Sunday of every month (or second to last if there are special events) anyone who has earned 4 pointes or more that month can get a treat that morning (they can be earned that morning). Treats will change–Donut, Muffin, Candy, Gummies, Snacks, TBD. On 5th Sundays we plan to have family Sundays. Before or after each service the NPKids Store will open. Parents may bring their children to shop with their pointes in The Studio. If we do not have a family Sunday and there is class in The Studio, we will have the store in another location.
