

## 84 Verses (1 a month for 7 years)

Bible Passage Memorization Challenge: Listed here are 84 passages of scripture that we desire every student to know and memorize by the time they graduate out of Journey. There will be a prize for any student who is able to completely memorize all of these verses by the time they graduate.

- 1. **1 Thessalonians 2:8** We cared so much for you that we were pleased to share with you not only the gospel of God but also our own lives, because you had become dear to us.
- 2. **Philippians 3:12** Not that I have already reached the goal or am already perfect, but I make every effort to take hold of it because I also have been taken hold of by Christ Jesus.
- 3. **2 Timothy 3:16-17** <sup>16</sup> All Scripture is inspired by God and is profitable for teaching, for rebuking, for correcting, for training in righteousness, <sup>17</sup> so that the man of God may be complete, equipped for every good work.
- 4. **1 Corinthians 6:19-20** <sup>19</sup> Don't you know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit who is in you, whom you have from God? You are not your own, <sup>20</sup> for you were bought at a price. So glorify God with your body.
- 5. **Deuteronomy 31:6** Be strong and courageous; don't be terrified or afraid of them. For the LORD your God is the one who will go with you; he will not leave you or abandon you."
- 6. **Matthew 5:28** But I tell you, everyone who looks at a woman lustfully has already committed adultery with her in his heart.
- 7. Proverbs 4:23 Guard your heart above all else, for it is the source of life.
- 8. **Matthew 6:33** But seek first the kingdom of God and his righteousness, and all these things will be provided for you.
- 9. Matthew 6:27 Can any of you add one moment to his life span by worrying?
- 10. **Philippians 4:6-7 6** Don't worry about anything, but in everything, through prayer and petition with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. **7** And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds in Christ Jesus.
- 11. 1 Peter 5:7 ... casting all your cares on him, because he cares about you.
- 12. **James 1:19-21** <sup>19</sup> My dear brothers and sisters, understand this: Everyone should be quick to listen, slow to speak, and slow to anger, <sup>20</sup> for human anger does not accomplish God's righteousness. <sup>21</sup> Therefore, ridding yourselves of all moral filth and the evil that is so prevalent, humbly receive the implanted word, which is able to save your souls.
- 13. **1 Peter 1:13** Therefore, with your minds ready for action, be sober-minded and set your hope completely on the grace to be brought to you at the revelation of Jesus Christ.
- 14. **Psalm 119:11** I have treasured your word in my heart so that I may not sin against you.
- 15. James 4:7 Therefore, submit to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.
- 16. **Psalm 23:4** Even when I go through the darkest valley, I fear no danger, for you are with me; your rod and your staff—they comfort me.
- 17. **1 John 1:9** If we confess our sins, he is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- 18. Psalm 51:10 God, create a clean heart for me and renew a steadfast spirit within me.
- 19. **Genesis 2:18** Then the Lord God said, "It is not good for the man to be alone. I will make a helper corresponding to him."
- 20. **Proverbs 27:17** Iron sharpens iron, and one person sharpens another.

- 21. 1 John 4:11 Dear friends, if God loved us in this way, we also must love one another.
- 22. **Isaiah 41:10** Do not fear, for I am with you; do not be afraid, for I am your God. I will strengthen you; I will help you; I will hold on to you with my righteous right hand.
- 23. **1 Corinthians 10:13** No temptation has come upon you except what is common to humanity. But God is faithful; he will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, but with the temptation he will also provide the way outso that you may be able to bear it.
- 24. **Exodus 34:6-7** <sup>6</sup> The Lord passed in front of him and proclaimed: The Lord—the Lord is a compassionate and gracious God, slow to anger and abounding in faithful love and truth, <sup>7</sup> maintaining faithful love to a thousand generations, forgiving iniquity, rebellion, and sin. But he will not leave the guilty unpunished, bringing the consequences of the fathers' iniquity on the children and grandchildren to the third and fourth generation.
- 25. **Psalm 127:1-2** <sup>1</sup> Unless the Lord builds a house, its builders labor over it in vain; unless the Lord watches over a city, the watchman stays alert in vain. <sup>2</sup> In vain you get up early and stay up late, working hard to have enough food—yes, he gives sleep to the one he loves.
- 26. **Galatians 5:22-23** <sup>22</sup> But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, <sup>23</sup> gentleness, and self-control. The law is not against such things.
- 27. **Ephesians 2:8-10** <sup>8</sup> For you are saved by grace through faith, and this is not from yourselves; it is God's gift—<sup>9</sup> not from works, so that no one can boast. <sup>10</sup> For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared ahead of time for us to do.
- 28. **Romans 1:16** For I am not ashamed of the gospel, because it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes, first to the Jew, and also to the Greek.
- 29. **Matthew 28:18-20** <sup>18</sup> Jesus came near and said to them, "All authority has been given to me in heaven and on earth. <sup>19</sup> Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, <sup>20</sup> teaching them to observe everything I have commanded you. And remember, I am with you always, to the end of the age."
- 30. **Matthew 19:26** Jesus looked at them and said, "With man this is impossible, but with God all things are possible."
- 31. **John 3:16** For God loved the world in this way: He gave his one and only Son, so that everyone who believes in him will not perish but have eternal life.
- 32. Philippians 4:13 I am able to do all things through him who strengthens me.
- 33. **1 Corinthians 10:31** So, whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do, do everything for the glory of God.
- 34. **Psalm 111:10** The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom; all who follow his instructions have good insight. His praise endures forever.
- 35. **Philippians 2:1-2** <sup>1</sup> If, then, there is any encouragement in Christ, if any consolation of love, if any fellowship with the Spirit, if any affection and mercy, <sup>2</sup> make my joy complete by thinking the same way, having the same love, united in spirit, intent on one purpose.
- 36. **Philippians 2:3-4** <sup>3</sup> Do nothing out of selfish ambition or conceit, but in humility consider others as more important than yourselves. <sup>4</sup> Everyone should look not to his own interests, but rather to the interests of others.
- 37. **Philippians 2:12** Therefore, my dear friends, just as you have always obeyed, so now, not only in my presence but even more in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling.
- 38. **Joshua 1:9** "...Haven't I commanded you: be strong and courageous? Do not be afraid or discouraged, for the LORD your God is with you wherever you go."
- 39. **Joshua 24:14-15** <sup>14</sup> "Therefore, fear the Lord and worship him in sincerity and truth. Get rid of the gods your ancestors worshiped beyond the Euphrates River and in Egypt, and worship the Lord. <sup>15</sup> But if it doesn't please you to worship the Lord, choose for yourselves today: Which will you worship—the gods

your ancestors worshiped beyond the Euphrates River or the gods of the Amorites in whose land you are living? As for me and my family, we will worship the LORD."

- 40. **Romans 10:14** How, then, can they call on him they have not believed in? And how can they believe without hearing about him? And how can they hear without a preacher?
- 41. **Psalms 119:105** Your word is a lamp for my feet and a light on my path.
- 42. **Proverbs 3:5-6** <sup>5</sup> Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and do not rely on your own understanding; <sup>6</sup> in all your ways know him, and he will make your paths straight.
- 43. **Revelations 4:11** Our Lord and God, you are worthy to receive glory and honor and power, because you have created all things, and by your will they exist and were created.
- 44. **Revelations 7:17** For the Lamb who is at the center of the throne will shepherd them; he will guide them to springs of the waters of life, and God will wipe away every tear from their eyes.
- 45. **1 Corinthians 13:1-3** <sup>1</sup> If I speak human or angelic tongues but do not have love, I am a noisy gong or a clanging cymbal. <sup>2</sup> If I have the gift of prophecy and understand all mysteries and all knowledge, and if I have all faith so that I can move mountains but do not have love, I am nothing. <sup>3</sup> And if I give away all my possessions, and if I give over my body in order to boast but do not have love, I gain nothing.
- 46. **1 Corinthians 13:4-8** <sup>4</sup> Love is patient, love is kind. Love does not envy, is not boastful, is not arrogant, <sup>5</sup> is not rude, is not self-seeking, is not irritable, and does not keep a record of wrongs. <sup>6</sup> Love finds no joy in unrighteousness but rejoices in the truth. <sup>7</sup> It bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things. <sup>8</sup> Love never ends. But as for prophecies, they will come to an end; as for tongues, they will cease; as for knowledge, it will come to an end.
- 47. **Luke 10:27** He answered, "Love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your strength, and with all your mind," and "your neighbor as yourself."
- 48. **2 Kings 10:16** Then he said, "Come with me and see my zeal for the Lord!" So he let him ride with him in his chariot.
- 49. John 4:24 "God is spirit, and those who worship him must worship in Spirit and in truth."
- 50. **John 14:6** Jesus told him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me."
- 51. **Isaiah 36:26** I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit within you; I will remove your heart of stone and give you a heart of flesh.
- 52. **1 Corinthians 12:9** But he said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is perfected in weakness." Therefore, I will most gladly boast all the more about my weaknesses, so that Christ's power may reside in me.
- 53. **Hebrews 6:19** We have this hope as an anchor for the soul, firm and secure. It enters the inner sanctuary behind the curtain.
- 54. **John 15:4** Remain in me, and I in you. Just as a branch is unable to produce fruit by itself unless it remains on the vine, neither can you unless you remain in me.
- 55. **Romans 8:1-2** <sup>1</sup> Therefore, there is now no condemnation for those in Christ Jesus, <sup>2</sup> because the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has set you free from the law of sin and death.
- 56. **Romans 8:38-39** <sup>38</sup> For I am persuaded that neither death nor life, nor angels nor rulers, nor things present nor things to come, nor powers, <sup>39</sup> nor height nor depth, nor any other created thing will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord.
- 57. **James 1:17** Every good and perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of lights, who does not change like shifting shadows.
- 58. **Exodus 3:14** God replied to Moses, "I AM WHO I AM. This is what you are to say to the Israelites: I AM has sent me to you."
- 59. **1 Corinthians 2:12** Now we have not received the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who comes from God, so that we may understand what has been freely given to us by God.

- 60. **Psalm 1:1-2** <sup>1</sup> How happy is the one who does not walk in the advice of the wicked or stand in the pathway with sinners or sit in the company of mockers! <sup>2</sup> Instead, his delight is in the LORD's instruction, and he meditates on it day and night.
- 61. **Romans 12:3** For by the grace given to me, I tell everyone among you not to think of himself more highly than he should think. Instead, think sensibly, as God has distributed a measure of faith to each one. 62. James 5:15 The prayer of faith will save the sick person, and the Lord will raise him up; if he has committed sins, he will be forgiven.
- 63. **Colossians 2:6-7** <sup>6</sup> So then, just as you have received Christ Jesus as Lord, continue to walk in him, <sup>7</sup> being rooted and built up in him and established in the faith, just as you were taught, and overflowing with gratitude.
- 64. **Colossians 2:13-14** <sup>13</sup> And when you were dead in trespasses and in the uncircumcision of your flesh, he made you alive with him and forgave us all our trespasses. <sup>14</sup> He erased the certificate of debt, with its obligations, that was against us and opposed to us, and has taken it away by nailing it to the cross.
- 65. **Colossians 3:1-2** <sup>1</sup> So if you have been raised with Christ, seek the things above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God. <sup>2</sup> Set your minds on things above, not on earthly things.
- 66. **Romans 12:1-2** <sup>1</sup> Therefore, brothers and sisters, in view of the mercies of God, I urge you to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God; this is your true worship. <sup>2</sup> Do not be conformed to this age, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, so that you may discern what is the good, pleasing, and perfect will of God.
- 67. **2 Corinthians 10:5** ...and every proud thing that is raised up against the knowledge of God, and we take every thought captive to obey Christ.
- 68. **Ephesians 6:12** For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the cosmic powers of this darkness, against evil, spiritual forces in the heavens.
- 69. **Ephesians 6:13** For this reason take up the full armor of God, so that you may be able to resist in the evil day, and having prepared everything, to take your stand.
- 70. **James 5:13-15** <sup>13</sup> Is anyone among you suffering? He should pray. Is anyone cheerful? He should sing praises. <sup>14</sup> Is anyone among you sick? He should call for the elders of the church, and they are to pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord. <sup>15</sup> The prayer of faith will save the sick person, and the Lord will raise him up; if he has committed sins, he will be forgiven.
- 71. **Psalm 103:2-4** <sup>2</sup> My soul, bless the LORD, and do not forget all his benefits. <sup>3</sup> He forgives all your iniquity; he heals all your diseases. <sup>4</sup> He redeems your life from the Pit; he crowns you with faithful love and compassion.
- 72. Jeremiah 17:14 Heal me, Lord, and I will be healed; save me, and I will be saved, for you are my praise.
- 73. **Jeremiah 29:11** For I know the plans I have for you"—this is the Lord's declaration—"plans for your well-being, not for disaster, to give you a future and a hope.
- 74. Jeremiah 29:13 You will seek me and find me when you search for me with all your heart.
- 75. **Matthew 6:14-15** <sup>14</sup> "For if you forgive others their offenses, your heavenly Father will forgive you as well. <sup>15</sup> But if you don't forgive others, your Father will not forgive your offenses.
- 76. Romans 12:18 If possible, as far as it depends on you, live at peace with everyone.
- 77. **John 8:12** Jesus spoke to them again: "I am the light of the world. Anyone who follows me will never walk in the darkness but will have the light of life."
- 78. Romans 3:23 For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God...
- 79. Romans 6:23 For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.
- 80. Romans 5:8 But God proves his own love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.
- 81. **Romans 10:9-10** <sup>9</sup> If you confess with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. <sup>10</sup> One believes with the heart, resulting in righteousness, and one confesses with the mouth, resulting in salvation.

- 82. Romans 10:13 For everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.
- 83. **Acts 2:42-47** <sup>42</sup> They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching, to the fellowship, to the breaking of bread, and to prayer. <sup>43</sup> Everyone was filled with awe, and many wonders and signs were being performed through the apostles. <sup>44</sup> Now all the believers were together and held all things in common. <sup>45</sup> They sold their possessions and property and distributed the proceeds to all, as any had need. <sup>46</sup> Every day they devoted themselves to meeting together in the temple, and broke bread from house to house. They ate their food with joyful and sincere hearts, <sup>47</sup> praising God and enjoying the favor of all the people. Every day the Lord added to their number those who were being saved.
- 84. Psalm 118:24 This is the day the Lord has made; let's rejoice and be glad in it.
